Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw

RESORT VILLAGE OF GLEN HARBOUR BYLAW NO 65/2023 A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Resort Village of Glen Harbour in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Resort Village of Glen Harbour.
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with
 - The rates contained within the Schedule B-Service fees as described in the Fire Suppression Agreement with the Town of Strasbourg which may be revised from time to time.
- 3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid
